The CTA SureSteel tactiles installed at the new American Express building feature a stepped side face and a concentric ring top surface, which has secured them an anti-slip safety rating of R13, as tested by the CSIRO.

They comply with the Building Code of Australia and meet all aspects of the Australian Standard: Design for Access and Mobility - AS1428.4:2002. Manufactured from one solid piece of 316 stainless steel, the tactile head will never detach from the anchoring sprigot.
